DCH-RP project is focused on:

- Strategic actions
 - To design and validate the preservation Roadmap for DCH
- Experimental tools
 - To define practical tools and carry out proofs of concept

The Roadmap will be supported by the execution of practical tools for decision makers and validated through a range of proofs of concept where cultural institutions and e-infrastructure providers will work together
