1. Welcome and administration

(discussion, 14:00 – 14:05)

- The PMB Chair opens the meeting and welcomes the participants.
- The meeting is quorate.
- Catherine Gater is appointed as note taker.
- The agenda is approved.
- Minutes for 26 June 2013 are approved without further comments.

2. Feedback and discussion from the EAC

(discussion, 14:05 – 14:15)

- The EAC commends the project on its progress since the last meeting
- The EAC notes concerns around the follow on funding under H2020 and funding for EGI.eu from Council fees
- NGIs and EC should be made fully aware of the consequences of non-payment or reduction of fees and of delays to the opening of calls.
- The EAC foresees impacts on the NGIs if EGI.eu is under-resourced, including loss of expertise and potential loss of users
- The EC projects that currently depend on EGI.eu should be documented
- Be creative about sources of funding e.g. capital funds
- Consider freezing the project in an 'operations only' mode
- The consequences of any loss of service and failures as a result of moving to this mode should be documented
- EAC records their appreciation of SN's contribution to the project

ACTION: EGI-InSPIRE Director to advise EC on projects depending on EGI.eu in an impact report

4. Response to 3rd EC Review

(discussion, 14:20 - 14:35)

- EC review text reviewed and actions identified for PMB, EGI.eu and/or Council and technical actions for project staff
- Remove inactive partners from the project and redeploy their resources
- Consider a project extension of 6 months or more
- Maintain strategic planning activities
- Continue to develop the business plan to protect EGI.eu
- Maintain and extend outreach to new communities through the human networks (including NILs) and DoW extension
- No response sent to the EC within the 30 day limit as no clarification of the review comments was needed on this occasion
- Agreement needed from the PMB on the proposed follow up actions

DISCUSSION

PMB discusses the role of the product development expert. External consultants can be time consuming and expensive to brief in some cases (IC). In other cases, soliciting advice on business development by an individual formerly in the grid field has given useful input (DK). Options are:

- to recruit to the role at the pay scale identified
- to allocate 3rd party funds in the DoW amendment for an external consultant
- seek advice from another EC project working in this area
- second an NGI member of staff for 6 months at 100% funding

DISCUSSION

PMB discusses sending a response that highlights the agreement of the PMB with the EC on the need for sustainability. The response should also outline the challenges that a delay in the closure of the first H2020 calls would cause.

ACTION: EGI-InSPIRE Director to draft a response to the EC review report on behalf of the PMB

5. EGI-InSPIRE Extension

(discussion, 14:35-16:05)

- Treat PY5 as a new project
- Bridge key activities to align with follow-on projects, and continue activities that we will seek funding for
- Implement the review recommendations
- Key challenge is uncertainty in the funding through EGI.eu and the EC
- PMB should decide how much money to reclaim from partners underspent in PY4
- PMB should decide for how long to extend the project 0,1,8 or 12 months
- Most partners want to be active in PY5 in at least some activities
- Funding for Core EGI activities based on EGI.eu fees or EC funds?
- Overview of changes in each work package provided
- Core EGI activities continue outside the project
- NA2 continues with the fewer staff at EGI.eu with funding for NILs, NOMs and champions
- SA5 replaces some SA1/JRA1 elements in the areas of training, technical and outreach
- Optional extras include a DRI ERIC and a second round of mini projects

DISCUSSION

Contribution of 5% of resources to the resource pool may not suit NGIs who do not own resources e.g. UK (DB).

There are 12 partners in the federated cloud infrastructure, providing sites as a test bed. There are around 1000 cores participating. Some sites have only a few tens of cores, as do some grid sites within the production infrastructure.

DISCUSSION

SN: Project extension of 6 months should focus funds on bridging activities to H2020

CD: A longer extension risks failure to extend the funds as far as necessary, and failure to deliver tasks to users at the end of the project, which would affect EGI's reputation.

SN: Key support needed for an extension is from the Project Officer at the EC.

DF: Treating PY5 as a new project opens up discussion on what needs to change going into H2020, for example in the governance and funding structure. The indications from the EC are that they are looking for change from EGI, as they want to provide funds to other communities.

SN: Sustainability was included in the original DoW for EGI at the EC's request, as this was the purpose of the call. A core set of activities has been well defined to operate outside European funding, but this is dependent on committed funds from the NGIs and acceptance by the research community of the services offered.

CD: The Commission should be made clearly aware of what is sustainable without EC funding and what is not.

IC: Lobbying activities in Brussels should focus on securing EC funding for EGI in the same way as has been achieved by other communities and e-infrastructures.

PMB discusses the development of a grand vision and plan, to extend services beyond the HEP community. The PMB worked to develop the strategy deliverable D2.20 EGI Sustainability Plan in PY2. This strategic role now sits with the Council.

SN: 800K is needed per annum from participant fees to support EGI-InSPIRE staff at EGI.eu, 800K is budgeted to support the EGI core activities.

The PMB members provide opinions on a 6 months extension, to be verified by the CB members and Council as appropriate.

DECISION

The PMB requests that the Grand Vision be agreed and presented to the PMB as soon as possible.

The PMB agrees in principal to a 6 month extension, subject to approval by the CB groupings.

ACTION: CD to set up a Doodle poll on the length of the extension that is acceptable to PMB members.

6. Project Staff at EGI.eu

(discussion, 16:05 – 16:25)

- The Executive Board will propose to the Council to start the search for a full EGI Director at the meeting on 20 September.
- In the interim, the EB will propose to the Council on 20 September that Tiziana Ferrari be appointed as the EGI-InSPIRE Director
- Hand over of the role from SN to Tiziana is expected to take place on or after 1 October
- The EB will propose an Interim EGI Director to the Council on 20 September

DISCUSSION

The terms of employment for the new full EGI Director will be addressed by the search committee on behalf of the Council.

The adjustment of roles within EGI.eu, for example in operations, will be considered by the EB once the Interim EGI Director appointment is confirmed by the Council.

DECISION

The nominations for activity managers should be approved by the PMB and the PMB agrees that this will take place by email or telcon.

The PMB members present approve Tiziana Ferrari as EGI-InSPIRE Director, subject to approval of this proposal by the Council.

The PMB agrees that a CB meeting to formally approve the extension will be held once the new EGI-InSPIRE Director is able to provide detail on the DoW content.
