#### Remarks about conference:

- Login process to access administrative part website is very confusing. You cannot login using OpenConext, nor with your email address. You are assigned a username, which you do not know and turns out to be 'first name-space-lastname'.
- The information that was included in our original session proposal (speakers bio's, remote speaker, session setup, presentation titles) have not been imported into the program, we were asked to provide this information again, multiple times.
- The session chairs have no means of checking whether their session speakers have uploaded their slides
- There is no logout button anywhere to switch user or to simply logout of the user website.
- The slide decks uploaded to the website in the end become visible. This means you cannot upload powerpoint with notes included (which is useful when giving the presentation), because generally you don't want to give this information to attendees. Maybe it is better to give the opportunity to upload slides for giving the presentation and upload a pdf that is visible to all attendees?
- The website is not compatible with iOS.
- We were never asked to provide text about our session and presentations for the conference4me app (with a max number of words), also a deadline for providing the text in time was never given. Both I would like to encourage for next time.
