The <u>EGI Conference 2016</u> took place in Amsterdam, Netherlands, 5-8 April 2016. The event was hosted by the EGI Foundation. The goal of the conference was to put research communities, NGIs and EIROs and collaborating e-Infrastructures in the spotlight as key players for the delivery of digital services for borderless science.

The event was attended by 188 participants. The follow-up survey was filled by 40 attendants.

Designed with research communities in mind, the DI4R 2016 event aimed to foster broader adoption of digital infrastructure services and promote user-driven innovation.
